From the TJHS President



Our winter board meeting, held in Victoria January 14-16, 2000, provided an opportunity for 70 people to come together for a marvelous weekend of activities.

This was the largest turnout we have had for a board meeting and we hope it sets a precedent. We prayed together at Temple B'nai Israel, we socialized with the Victoria Jewish community at a lovely Oneg Shabbat and we heard about the Jewish community of Victoria from Dave Lack and Halletsville from Armand Schwartz. Author Hollace Weiner spoke about her interesting travels promoting her terrific book, "Jewish Stars in Texas-Rabbis and their Work" and she signed so many books I wondered if she might have writer's cramp. TJHS sold an entire case of 28 books and Hollace told us the book is already getting ready for it's second printing! We are so proud to be among the sponsors of this fine historic volume.

TJHS member Max Stool shared the video he made on his recent ShtetlSchleppers trip to Ukraine where he visited with his relatives. The travel department of Jewishgen.com planned this trip and Max was very complimentary about their arrangements. His words and photographs made us feel a part of this unique experience. Noel Graubart also shared some information about his trip to Poland where he was able to locate someone who had

known his mother and her family. We feel like "meshpocha" when we share these experiences.

Saturday evening, at an elegant dinner at the Palace Club, we viewed a very unusual and moving film called, "The Secrets of the Jewish Brigade during World War II." These Jewish soldiers serving in the British Army played an important role during the war that had not been previously documented. Their abilities as trained British soldiers also had an important impact on Israel's War of Independence. This film was funded by the Stephen Spielberg Foundation and is a combination of documentary footage as well as personal interviews with the participants.
